***CAMERON COUNTY INITIATES COUNTY-WIDE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT
PROGRAM FOR MUNICIPALITIES***

Cameron County has initiated an innovative program to assist various municipalities located within the county to replace aging bridge structures.

Through a state designation, Cameron County is eligible to receive funding through Act 26 for county bridge projects. The county has agreed to pass these savings on to townships by taking over ownership of each eligible bridge, which requires replacement.

The county at a municipal meeting held at the Cameron County Courthouse in Emporium unveiled this program. Details of the program were reviewed and questions were answered of the municipalities.

This program not only passes savings on to various municipalities but also fosters positive working relationships between Cameron County and townships. Only one other county to date has entered into such a program.

All municipalities owning bridges have expressed interest and have joined the program, bringing some thirteen bridges with them for consideration. Field views are being completed by county engineer P. JOSEPH LEHMAN, INC., Consulting Engineers, who is preparing a prioritized list of projects.
