Lehman Engineers Horse Trail Ride and NEW Trail Walk To Benefit *Dreams Go On*

Hollidaysburg, PA--On **Sunday, September 28th**, 2014, the 8th annual Lehman Engineers Horse Trail Ride to benefit *Dreams Go On*, a non-profit therapeutic horseback riding organization, will take place at Canoe Creek State Park. *Dreams Go On* (501C3 nonprofit) provides therapeutic horseback riding sessions for adults and children who are physically challenged, receive mental health, behavioral health or family therapy services. New for this year's event is a trail walk in addition to the horse trail ride. Two choices for the walk are available. Registrants can choose the Limestone Trail (1.2 miles) near the kilns with a view of a scenic stream or lakeview: a ½ mile handicap accessible loop (1/4 portion of the loop is crushed limestone) that can be repeated for 1 to 5 miles while enjoying the beautiful view of the lake. For horseback riders, the Bridle Trail loops around the park and will be between 2 - 2.5 hour trail ride. Check-in and registration on the day of the event is at 9:00 a.m. for horse trail riders and at 10:15 a.m. for trail walkers. The horse trail ride begins at 10:00 a.m. and the trail walk begins at 11 a.m. Whether riding on horseback or walking a trail, the beautiful scenery at the 958-acre Canoe Creek State Park provides an atmosphere to reflect with nature and help out a very worthy cause.

Trail riders and trail walkers are encouraged to register online prior to the event and collect pledges to donate to *Dreams Go On*. Trophies are awarded for the top fundraising individual and top fundraising team. A free t-shirt will be given to the first 50 registered horse trail riders and trail walkers and all are invited to a free BBQ chicken lunch with potato salad, baked beans, and dinner rolls thanks to the generosity of Imler's Poultry, Duncansville, Pa. Chicken BBQ and meal will be prepared by Clyde Monahan, the General Manager of Imler's Poultry. Horseback riders are invited to "Ride or Walk with Joe", Joe Murgo, WTAJ's Chief Meteorologist, will once again be the Master of Ceremonies. Riders can also meet Christian Anderson from Bellwood, the 2014 *Dreams Go On* Trail Ride Ambassador. Christian is enjoying his fourth year riding with *Dreams Go On*. He is advancing in the program and has become quite independent with his riding skills.

The trails will be groomed prior to the ride by *Dreams Go On* Volunteers: Joanne and Steve Nader. The therapeutic horseback riding instructor from *Dreams Go On*, Karen Strayer, will lead and guide the horseback trail riders. Sue Lehman, founder of Dreams Go On, and Jeff Kennedy, *Dreams Go On* Volunteer, will lead the trail walkers to their respective routes. Lunch will be served at 12:30 in Pavilion #2 for all registered participants and *Dreams Go On* riders and their families. All are encouraged to bring a picnic blanket and continue enjoying Canoe Creek State Park after lunch.
