

# Trail ride benefits 'Dreams Go On'

HOLLIDAYSBURG — A horseback ride to benefit Dreams Go On, a non-profit therapeutic horseback riding organization, will take place at Canoe Creek State Park on Sunday, Oct. 4.

The 3rd annual Lehman Engineers Horse Trail Ride loops around the park and will be between a 3 1/2 to 4-hour trail ride. There is no registration fee to participate in the event.

Registration on the day of the event is at 8 a.m. The ride begins promptly at 9 a.m. The Bridle Trail, laid out by Terry Wentz of WaxWing Associates, The trail will be groomed through the state park, and an instructor from Dreams Go On will lead and guide the trail riders. Lunch will be served at noon in Pavilion No. 2 for the registered participants and Dreams Go On riders and their families. Riders are encouraged to enjoy continuing to ride at Canoe Creek after the lunch.

Registered horse trail riders may participate in the silent auction being held from 12:30 to 1 p.m. After lunch, Christine Wertz, riding instructor, will speak about the Parelli
